- Lenten Lunches. St Cybi's/Eglwys Y Bedd this year, as previous years, hosted the Lenten Lunches held every Wednesday. Each Church has organised a lunch whilst Mothers' Union undertakes to provide the sustenance for the first and last lunches. The lunches have so far been well supported with all proceeds being donated to Christian Aid.
- Women's World Day of Prayer. This Ecumenical Service was for 2016 hosted by St Cybi's on the 4 March; the designated date for world-wide Services to be held. The country that planned the Service for this year and the centre of the prayers was Cuba with the theme 'Receive me, receive children'.
