Our diocesan vision

As Christians in the Diocese of Bangor, we can trace our history back to holy men and women who founded communities of prayer and service across the diocese as early as the fifth century. These early Celtic saints – Deiniol, Cybi, Seiriol, Tudwen, Madryn, and many others – are still commemorated in the names of our churches, villages and towns.

A millennium and a half later, our mission hasn't changed – but our context today is new and challenging.

Our response as a diocese has been to commit ourselves to a vision of following Jesus with new energy and in new ways, and to do so by establishing and advancing three key principles, three key priorities, three key plans, and three new platforms.

Our principles

In the Diocese of Bangor we are committed to three visionary principles which we believe should characterise our common life as a diocese:

- ◆ worshipping God
- ◆ growing the Church
- ◆ loving the world

These principles must be grounded in the contexts in which we live and work, in church and in community. But they require more than prayerful resolve and heartfelt commitment.

They require clear thinking, constant attention, and meaningful resourcing. We hope and pray that, so grounded, they may express both our hope and confidence in God, and our experience of the One whose reign of goodness and love will know no end.
