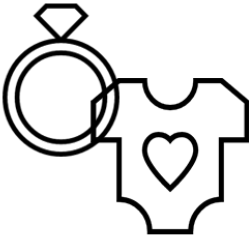

vid's Hospice in Penrhos Stanley.

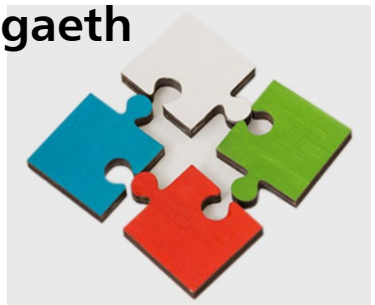

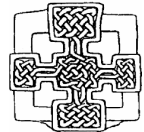

These early Celtic saints – Deiniol, Cybi, Seiriol, Tudwen, Madryn, and many others – are still commemorated in the names of our churches, villages and towns.
