Saints Days June 2016

11: Barnabas –Apostle: Though not named as one of the twelve apostles or an evangelist in the Acts of the Apostles, Barnabas appears to be one of the most significant. He sold his possessions and gave his money to the church, becoming a leader. Like his friend Paul, he was from the Greek world rather than the Palestinian. He introduced Paul to the church leaders in Jerusalem. Apparently he was martyred in Cyprus in the year 61AD.

24: Birth of John the Baptist: John was considered to be endowed with grace from before his birth. Both his leaping in his mother's womb in anticipation of the birth of Christ, and the fact that he was the anticipated forerunner of Christ, are reasons why the church has celebrated the day of his birth, rather than the date of his death.

29: Peter and Paul—Apostles: Both were leaders of the church, in very different ways. Peter was the rock on which Jesus would build his church—and he witnessed to the lordship of Christ. Paul was to develop an understanding of its meaning for Christ's followers. Both have been remembered jointly on this day since the very early days of the church, because it was seen as the anniversary of their martyrdom in Rome in about the year 64AD.
