What do we show on this month's cover? We see Tristan Roberts, Head Teacher of Ysgol Cybi, standing outside this incredible school, which celebrated its first anniversary last month. Although financed by the Anglesey County Council, it is Church in Wales supported. This means that although state funded, the Church in Wales has some influence over how it is run. The outside logo carries a brief reference to Christ, and in the foyer can be seen a simple wooden cross. Our clergy take assembly once each week, another morning sees classroom based mini assemblies, and Tristan takes assembly on a third morning. He focuses on Christian ethics such as thankfulness and kindness. A very high proportion of pupils choose to take part in Christian assemblies, and they thoroughly enjoy their outings to services in St Cybi. Throughout the school there is an over whelming atmosphere of joy and happiness, together with calm busy-ness! The Head is full of praise for the staff, the children, and the co-operation of the parents. He is grateful too for input from the church, and for the team of volunteers, who add to the children's educational experience. During my visit, a professional actor was leading the pupils in a lesson on the Connemara tragedy. Ysgol Cybi has not escaped the difficult economic situation, with County Council cuts meaning that there is a smaller budget this year. There is however a high visual level of technical support for children of all age groups. Plans are already in place for pupils to be part of the community 'one hundred year Leinster' commemoration. The Ucheldre Centre has already been booked for traditional Christmas carol services inspired by the Nativity. The traditional visit to a Christmas panto in Llandudno for the older children has been planned since January. When asked about how he relaxes, from such a stressful work load, Tristan indicated the many photographic landscapes adorning the walls of his office. The countryside and the camera are his calming influences, both in North Wales and on foreign travel. Due to a back injury, swimming has replaced five-a-side football as his sport of choice. Biographic reading, covering both the world of sport, politics and WW2 recruitment of spies is also a hobby. His musical tastes cover the guitar, rock band Oasis, and the recent Paul McCartney 'surprise gigs' in the Cavern. If teaching had not claimed him, he would have gone into journalism – he actually did a football commentary course in Bangor at the age of 16! He would like to be remembered as someone who always did his best, who was honest and tried to think about others. This school is truly inspirational! We ask for prayers for everyone connected to it: Head Teacher Tristan, staff, pupils, parents and volunteers. Thank you.

Interesting Historical October Dates! On the Ist, in 1949, the People's Republic of China was founded with Mao Zedong as Chairman. On the 6th in 1927 the first "talkie" opened in New York, after the 'silent' era . *The Jazz Singer* starring Al Jolson was the first full length feature film using spoken dialogue. On the 13th in 1792, the cornerstone of the White House was laid by George Washington. The building, located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue NW, Washington DC, is three stories tall with over 100 rooms, and was designed by James Hoban. It takes 570 gallons of paint to cover the external surfaces. On the 14th in 1066, the Norman Conquest began with the Battle of Hastings in which King Harold II of England, the last of the Saxon kings, was defeated and killed by William of Normandy's troops. On the 28th in 1919, prohibition began in the U.S. with the passage of the National Prohibition (Volstead) Act by Congress. Sales of drinks containing more than one half of one percent of alcohol became illegal. It lasted nearly 14 years and became highly profitable for organized crime which manufactured and sold liquor in saloons called speakeasies.
