

ANGLESEY PRAYER WALK

SATURDAY 18th JUNE 2016



This year we are inviting Christians across all denominations to join together in following in the footsteps of the two saints, **St. Cybi and St. Seiriol** who are credited with bringing the teachings of Christ to Anglesey over 1500 years ago. Using a route based on "The Two Lighthouses Walk"* we will re-enact their weekly prayer walk, dividing the route into 8 manageable sections. Starting at Holyhead and Penmon respectively we will walk the 8 sections concurrently, and meet at Clorach Well near Llanerchymedd. In this act of faith, we will demonstrate Christ's call to unite in love and faith, and pray:

**"MAY YOUR KINGDOM COME
MAY YOUR WILL BE DONE
ON ANGLESEY"**

Each section is about 5-6 miles. For those unable to walk, prayer houses will be open along the route.

6	Llanddona – Benllech	Llanddona church
7	Benllech – Lligwy	St Andrew's Benllech
8	Lligwy – Clorach Well	St Michael's, Penrhos Lligwy
