In this season of resurrection and new life, I wanted to share a real story with you – this

happened to me today. I've supported a man for 18 years, he was a boy when we first met.

He's always kept in touch with me and we talk sometimes every day on the phone. He was

14 when I first got to know him; he lived across the road and used to get up to no good in

our neighbourhood. He was big and tall and strong and he used his fists. He terrorised the

neighbourhood, and he robbed me and many others. He stabbed someone when he was 17

and was sentenced under Section 37 which means he will only be released by order of the

Home Secretary. That was 15 years ago. He phones me every few days, from jail. He always

wants to know how I am, how my family are(he knows my children)and he always ends our

chat with "love you". He's never shown any interest in faith at all. Tonight he rang me and

for the first time in 18 years he asked me to pray for him. He wants me to choose a bible for

him and send it to him and he says he chats with the 'vicar' in prison a lot now. That was

today's little miracle; 18 years in the making.

We have been faithful during this pandemic. We may not have got everything right, but we

have tried and God has taken care of us. He will always take care of us because He is good

and he is faithful to us. That is His covenant with us. He will always give us what we need,

not what we want; but what we need.

We want to know how you want us to keep communicating with you, now that changes are

happening and our churches are re-opening. There are several options for each of you,

please will you let Pat Hughes know what you want to receive in the future, the options are

as follows:

1) Do you want to continue receiving monthly envelopes

2) If so, which sheets do you wish to receive in the envelope

3) Are you happy to receive the information by e mail instead of by envelope

4) Would you like to pick up an envelope at your church – to save someone delivering it

If you are able to ring Pat on 01407 860412 and let her know your preference within the

next few weeks that would be hugely helpful.
